Guelph's Wellington Brewery is Canada's oldest independently owned microbrewery and was established in 1985. The first North American brewery in modern times to brew cask-conditioned Real Ale. The Wellington beer is brewed in small batches with natural ingredients and uses no cold filtration, natural carbonation, no pasteurization, and secondary fermentation in casks.The brewery's architecture is a homage to the traditional Oast house, the farm building used for drying hops in preparation for the brewing process.

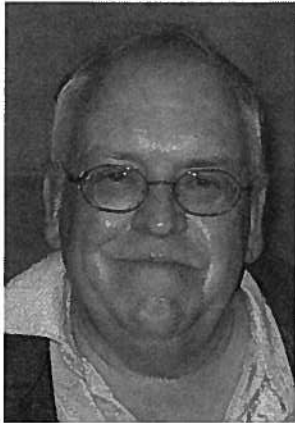
